

PILE BURNING FOR FUELS REDUCTION WORKSHOP

Learn how to safely and legally burn woody piles at your home or property with the tools you most likely already have.

The day will cover:

- How to create and burn safe, clean burning brush and woody debris piles
- What precautions are needed for pile burning in a location where water is not plumbed
- What permits are needed from air quality and fire districts
- The potential benefits of forest fuel reduction
- Ecological restoration opportunities associated with pile burning
