



# Community Meetings for the Gualala Roads Assessment Order

In-person: Thursday, April 9, 2026 | 2-4 pm

Virtual: Tuesday, April 14, 2026 | 5-7 pm

**All interested community members are invited to attend a community meeting for the Gualala Roads Assessment Order.** The North Coast Water Board is developing this order and will require the inventory, assessment, and prioritization of sediment-generating rural roads in the Gualala River Watershed. This will be one of two orders designed to improve road conditions, control excess sediment, and reduce elevated water temperatures. All of these reduce water quality and negatively impact the river's ecosystem, particularly its native salmon and trout populations.

This meeting will address road assessment elements and processes, land access agreements, and an update from the Technical Advisory Committee.

Sonoma Resource Conservation District (RCD) staff will be in attendance to connect with landowners and land managers in navigating this new water quality assessment order and provide on-the-ground technical assistance. The RCD provides non-regulatory, free assistance to our community.
