

Funding for Marin & Sonoma County Producers for Conservation Practices & Technical Assistance



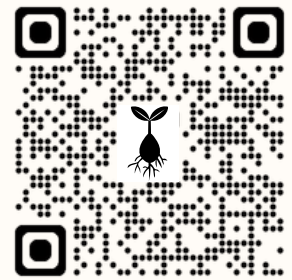
Sonoma Resource Conservation District has funding for producers through the **Advancing Markets for Producers (AMP)** program for the following conservation practices.

- Compost and/or gypsum application (includes soil/compost testing)
- Cover cropping
- Pasture and/or range seeding
- Fencing (temporary electric or permanent)

Funds will be distributed through a rebate program administered by the County of Sonoma. A second round of funding will be announced this upcoming winter. To receive funding, recipients must be enrolled with the Farm Service Agency (FSA), which Sonoma RCD can assist with as needed.
